Certificate in Christian Ministry

Description of the Programme

This programme is designed to help to equip persons such as Pastors, Evangelists, Missionaries, Church workers, and Parachurch Workers in effectively fulfilling the mandate of their ministry in their local church, communities, and the wider society.

Participants will be exposed to the different types of ministries both in the church and the community. This will enable them to minister/work with persons from different age groups such as children, youths, and the elderly.

Requirements

- All applicants for admission to the programme, normally, must possess at least 3 CXC/CSEC, or its equivalent. The subjects must include English language.
- 2 Passport size photographs
- Proof of Identification (Birth Certificate, National ID, Drivers License)
- Non-refundable application fee .
- ◆ The specialized nature of the programme require all applicants to submit a letter of recommendation from her/his church/denomination.
- Applicants who do not possess the requisite subjects but have been engaged in ministry may be accepted as a mature student.

A completed application form with the required application fee, certified copies of examination results and letters of recommendation must be submitted to the College.

Applicants may be required to attend an interview.

Duration of the Programme

The programme is normally offered over eighteen (18) months of full-time study and 24 months part time. Classes are held Mondays to Thursdays from 5:00—8:00 p.m.

Overview of the Curriculum

To be awarded the Certificate in Christian Ministry the student will be required to complete Thirty (30) credits distributed as outlined below:
